

## Senior Women's Football Coach

- Demonstrated experience at building and maintaining relationships with club stakeholders including coordination, collaboration and shared values with the committee and Senior Men's Football coaching staff
- Maintain contact with all current players and immediate past players that will contribute to the success of the squad and engage them to be available for selection in matchday team.
- Together with the recruitment coordinator lead and proactively assist recruitment of players.
- Provide game day coaching to the Senior Women's team throughout the season.
- Attend Club functions and promote a collaborative whole of club culture amongst the playing group.
- Understand and appreciate the environment and requirements around the ethos of amateur football.
